

Policy on Committees and Committee Development

Adopted by the general membership at the 2012 AGM
Revised July 21, 2012

The Georgia Soccer Bylaws establish standing committees considered essential to the conducting of the business of the Association. The Board of Directors may form additional committees from time to time as the need arises to conduct the needs of the Association on an ongoing basis. The Board may also form task forces to accomplish a specific task or complete a designated project for the benefit of the Association; a task force would disband once its task is completed.

Requests for additional committees or task forces specific to youth or adult programs shall originate from the appropriate Vice President, who shall appoint a chair for the committee, subject to approval of the Board of Directors. For committees or task forces that serve the Association as a whole, the President shall appoint a chair, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

The committees listed below, should they continue to exist or be re-established, will be appointed as detailed here:

State Cup Committee

Adult State Cup Committee Chair appointed by the Vice President-Adult

Youth State Cup Committee Chair appointed by the Vice President-Youth

Elite Player Development Committee

Chair appointed by Vice President-Youth, with the approval of the Board of Directors

Three to five members appointed by the Chair with the approval of the Vice President- Youth Director of Coaching shall be a non-voting member of this committee.

Hall of Fame Committee

Per Hall of Fame Policy previously adopted by the Board of Directors

Information Technology Committee

The Chair, appointed by the President, will nominate three to six committee members, to be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors. Attempts will always be made to assure fair representation.

Marketing Committee

The chair appointed by the President, will nominate three to six committee members, to be appointed by the president with the approval of the Board of Directors. Attempts will always be made to assure fair representation.

Registrars Committee

Chair and additional member appointed by the President

Two of the four members recommended by each Vice President, -Adult and -Youth

The Executive Director, who serves as the State Registrar, shall be a non-voting member.

Risk Management Committee

The Chair, appointed by the President, will nominate three to six committee members, to be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors. Attempts will always be made to assure fair representation.

Tournament and Special Games Committee

Chair appointed by the President

Three additional members appointed by the President, including one recommended by each Vice President.

The Board will review existing committees and task forces, not specifically identified in the bylaws, annually to determine their viability, effectiveness and value for continued existence.
