semester.

Criteria: Applicants should have exemplary academic and extra-curricular histories.

Deadline: All applications and supporting documents must be received by June 9.

Awards: Recipients will be chosen and notified by July 20 with awards paid to the receiving

institution by August 15.

- o Copy of SAT and/or ACT scores
- o College or university letter of acceptance
- o Letter of Recommendation (Rich Freeman Scholarship only)
