

Policy on U.S. Soccer Bylaw 212

Pursuant to U.S. Soccer Bylaw 212, US Soccer and Georgia Soccer must require that every player or other person participating with each Affiliate is registered with an Organization Member of U.S. Soccer. U.S. Soccer Policy 212-1 allows Georgia Soccer to request reasonable proof that every player or other person participating with each Affiliate is registered with an Organization Member of U.S. Soccer. Georgia Soccer's Bylaws indicate that U.S. Soccer's Bylaws and Policies shall take precedence over Georgia Soccer's Bylaws. Georgia Soccer Bylaw 4.1 should be read consistently with U.S. Soccer Bylaw 212 and U.S. Soccer Policy 212-1. Therefore, all Georgia Soccer Affiliates must register every player and other person participating with an Organization Member of U.S. Soccer. If an Affiliate registers players or other persons participating with an Organization Member of U.S. Soccer other than Georgia Soccer, the Affiliate upon request will provide reasonable proof of such registration.
