COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

I WILL:

- Manage the team environment by setting a positive example for all to follow.
- Communicate pre- and post-game with players and parents.
- Respect the game, opponents, competition, officials, and all participants of the game.
- Continue to develop as a coach.
- Approach each game with a positive mindset.
- Be knowledgeable of the laws of the game and rules of competition, promoting positive actions and not tolerating actions that bring the game into disrepute.

- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting, condescending, or abusive language or behavior with anyone.
- Make myself familiar with Risk Management practices, understanding SafeSport and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies at Georgia Soccer.
- Be compliant with all Georgia State Soccer Association and US Soccer Risk Management policies, including maintaining SafeSport certification.

I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DO NOT FOLLOW THE CODE, I MAY BE:

- Asked to leave the club.
- Subject to having my coaching license suspended by US Soccer.
- Required to attend a discipline hearing at Georgia Soccer.
