US Soccer Regional Upgrade Requirements

Additional Georgia Soccer Regional Upgrade / Re-Certification Requirements

- Must Notify the State Referee Committee members (via email) of your intent to upgrade.
- New Regional Candidates MUST have a developmental field evaluation before submitting for a formal field evaluation.
- Starting 1 July, 2026, Georgia will follow the US Soccer registration year (currently 1 July to 30 June). All requirements MUST be completed within that time period or you will have to start over.

Requesting a Field Evaluation

- https://www.georgiasoccer.org/request-an-assessment/
- Ensure you select the correct evaluation type
 - National
 - Regular
- Ensure all information is correct (date, time, location, officials name(s)).
- Pay for the evaluation
 - National \$200 (mileage will be billed to you if applicable)
 - Regional, 2nd or more developmental \$150
 - Developmental \$0 (only once per referee)
- Should details of your specific game change, please edit the request (i.e. time, location, crew members).



Requesting a Field Evaluation

- Please ensure you keep your request up to date as crew members are added.
- Any changes / cancellations within 48 hours of game time require notification to the SDA and SRA via email. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of your fee and you will be billed for any mileage incurred.
- Should your game be cancelled, do not edit the original game when asking for another evaluation. Put in a new request, in the notes, state that the fee was paid for a game that was cancelled on xx (whatever date the original game was) and do not pay for the new evaluation.
- For a regional evaluation, I will not contact you if a Referee Coach has been assigned. You will only hear from me if one cannot be assigned.
- If your game is outside the metro Atlanta area, the chances of having a referee coach assigned to your game is much lower.
- Video evaluations for Regional purposes are not an option at this time.



National Evaluation Information

- Notify the SDA and SRA (via email) of your intention to upgrade.
- Once a National Referee Coach is assigned, communicate with them as soon as possible.
- If the evaluation is via video, ensure the NRC has a link to the game and line up the debrief with all crew members and the NRC (recommended for now is within 4 days of the game). This is your responsibility.
- AR evaluations
 - Video evaluations are tough (especially if you are on the same side of the field as the camera. Don't rely solely on them.
 - Try to pair your request with that of a referee needing a National Evaluation. It is not recommended to do this alone.
- If you have a game out of state that you want evaluated, feel free to get in touch with me for assistance. Most states do have a procedure similar to what we have in Georgia, however there are some exceptions to who assigns the NRC.



Other Advice

- Your off the field behavior matters!
- Your behavior in other organizations can affect you as well.
- Social media about assignments, only 24 hours AFTER the game has finished.
- There are only 10 referee coaches and 3 national referee coaches in Georgia.
- Out of state evaluations
 - Notify me via email
 - Follow procedure in the state you are going
 - Under no circumstances are you to pay a referee coach directly or line up a field evaluation on your own.
